It features many Czech folk instruments that may seem a bit foreign to the average person...dudy, fanfrnoch, vozembouch and hrábě. The only familiar instruments in the group may be the violin, E<sup>b</sup> clarinet and B<sup>b</sup> clarinet. Their music has developed over the centuries starting with simplistic vocal and bagpipe duets; maturing into what the ensemble represents today. The dudys' themselves were first mentioned in history in the Přemyslid Dynasty- 13<sup>th</sup> Century in Prague in The Chronicle of Zbraslav in 1297.
